

- Work distribution amongst three people with help from mentors



Design Process

Define Problem: Today's menstrual health apps and resources have been generalized to fit the target audience of adult women but not to adolescents (aged 9 to 18) which does not provide a safe educational space for them.

Brainstorm:

Our product would be targeted towards adolescents and would promote education and safe resources for them during this life-changing time without enforcing heternormative ideas and gender stereotypes.

Prototype:
